Chromebook pick-up for Learn at Home students Tuesday September 1, 8:00-12:00

If your child is enrolled in our Learn at Home program, please come to the school between the hours of 8 and 12 on 9/1 to pick-up a Chromebook from the front office. You will enter the main foyer wearing a mask, and you will be given the Chromebook that has been assigned to your student. If you did not return the Chromebook that your student used this past spring, it has been reassigned to them.

Chromebook pick-up WMS Wednesday September 2 and Thursday September 3, 9:00-11:00

In order to help our middle school students prepare for their off-site learning days and hybrid schedule, we will be distributing Chromebooks on 9/2 and 9/3 between 9 am and 11 am. All middle school students who have returned Chromebooks are asked to come to the school on one of these days. These days will also provide an opportunity for students to practice our new entrance and exit procedures. The entrance doors will be labeled by grade level with those riding buses entering on the RTE 114 side, and parent drop off students entering on our parking lot side. Once in the building, students will proceed to their grade level wing. Before they leave they can then visit the gym to pick-up their assigned Chromebook. Please note: Students entering the building must wear masks the entire time they are inside.

If you did not return the Chromebook your student used this past spring, that one has been reassigned to your student.

If you are unable to make this pick-up time and your student has available technology for 9/9, they can receive their Chromebook on the first on-site day (A-K on 9/10 or L-Z on 9/11). If they need a chromebook for the first day off-site learning (9/9) and you cannot make one of the pick-up times, please email our IT Director at chris.auger@sau24.org.

Chromebook pick-up Upper Elementary Wednesday September 2 and Thursday September 3, 8:00-10:00

Due to Chromebooks being back ordered, we are asking families to only pick-up a Chromebook if it is needed for the first off-site day on 9/9. If your child does require a Chromebook for our first off-site day on 9/9, please come to the school between 8-10 am

on 9/2 or 9/3. One adult may enter the building with your enrolled elementary child. All must wear masks.

Please help your child find the door their grade-level will enter by; bus drop-off is on the RTE 114 side with 4th grade entering through the farthest door on the left as you face the building and 5th grade through the second door on the left. Parent drop-off will have 4th grade enter next to the cafe and 5th grade through the northern side entrance (the one often used for recess). All doors will be labeled. Please then make your way to the hallway that hosts the appropriate grade level. Once you have practiced that pathway, continue to the gym to pick-up a Chromebook.

Since these grades are scheduled to be in our building 5 days a week, we are prioritizing Chromebooks with our older students who have a hybrid model. We will be assigning Chromebooks to all students but will not have the quantity we need until at least October. We apologize and ask for your patience. It is possible that the requests for Chromebooks at the 4th and 5th grades outpaces our ability to fill that need. If that occurs, we will do our best to look for further solutions.

1:40-1:50 Students with last names D-G and N-S

1:50-2:00 Students with last names H-K and T-Z
