

Good Afternoon Everyone,

We apologize for giving you another piece of information to deal with, but we have opted to use a screening program for students that is linked to our Pickup Patrol Program.

We are asking that everyone run through the screener in preparation for using it on the first student day to screen your student/students for Covid-19 symptoms.

When you access the screener, you'll be able to screen each child in your household with the **six daily questions**. The questions are:

- **Is the student experiencing new congestion, runny nose, difficulty breathing, cough, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell?**
- **Is the student experiencing new body aches, headache, chills or fatigue?**
- **Is the student experiencing new GI symptoms: nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?**
- **Does the student have a fever of 100.4 degrees or greater?**
- **Has the student been exposed to someone with a diagnosed or suspected case of COVID-19?**
- **Has the student travelled outside New England in the last 14 days?**

If the answer to any of the questions is 'yes' you will be prompted to call the school nurse's office at 529-8015 or 529-8029 for a secondary screening to see if your child can still come to school. The office is staffed starting at 7:15 AM daily.

Screening should be completed before children leave for school. You'll get a reminder email at 7:15 daily if the screener is not complete yet.

If children arrive at school without being screened, they will be screened by school staff before being allowed to go to class.

REGISTRATION: **Be on the lookout for an email from Pickup Patrol (PUP) with a registration link.** You must register with this link BEFORE you can log into the app. This email describes several uses for PUP. Our school will be using PUP for submitting plan changes, dismissal tracking, attendance reporting and daily health screening.

ADDING THE APP TO YOUR PHONE: The app is free to parents and you can use it from your smartphone or computer. The PUP App is not downloaded from the app store. For instructions on how to add it to your phone click [HERE](#).

REMINDER: You will receive a reminder, if you forget to submit. As unsubmitted screenings will require followup, so we also suggest you set up your own reminder. If you have any questions, please contact us here in the office at 603-529-7555 or Pickup Patrol at support@pickuppatrol.net.
