Academic Assistance Program

The Academic Assistance Program (AAP) offers free assistance with homework and other assignments to all WMS students. Students must submit a signed parent permission form to attend.

- AAP meets Monday – Friday from 2:05 – 2:55 starting the first day of school until the last. (Please note that AAP will not be available on early release days.)
- AAP meets in Mrs. Crosby’s (Health) room.
- Students are expected to arrive on time with all the materials needed to complete their assignments. Students who have completed their assignments for the day need to bring material to either read, write, or practice math. Computers are available if students need them.
- All school rules and expectations apply to AAP.
- Students who have after-school sports will change during AAP and be dismissed at the same time as all the rest of the students. Please do not wear cleats in the building.
- There is no supervision after 2:55, unless students are enrolled in the CASA program, or headed to a sports practice or game. Please pick up your child(ren) promptly at 2:55. If you need to collect your child before dismissal, please check in at the office as you would during the school day.
- Attendance is based on your child's need. Your child may attend a few times a week, or attend every day.
- Students are allowed to eat snacks.
